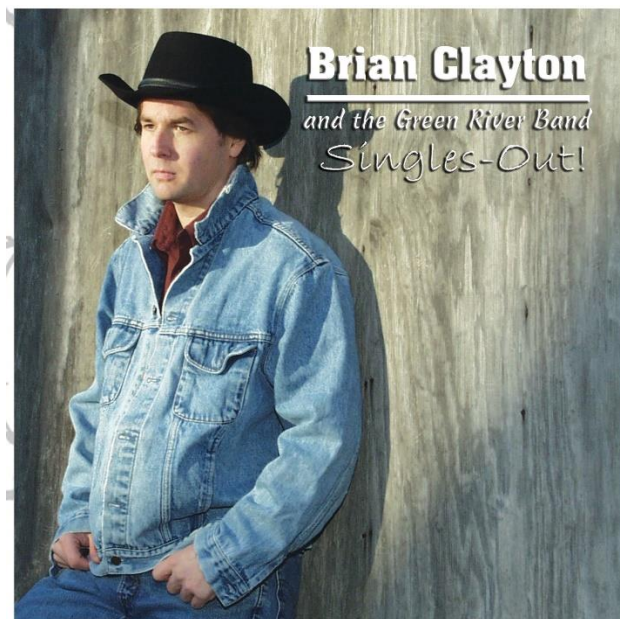

BRIAN CLAYTON

BRIAN CLAYTON, raised in Garwood, New Jersey, started playing drums and singing at the early age of 4 and by 12 formed his first band. While in high school, Brian showed a special interest in acting and appeared in numerous national TV commercials and feature films.

Soon afterwards, Brian joined an original group called the "Skates", which gave him his first taste of professional studio recording. The Skates eventually evolved into a country oriented rock act called "The Pressures of Time". The band had a southern sound with quality original material. The Pressures exposed Brian to the country styles of Steve Earle, The Kentucky Headhunters and Dwight Yoakam. The group secured a management-production deal with Westwood Entertainment Group. Brian went on to co-produce two unsigned artists CD compilations for Westwood and executive produced The Pressures only release, "Down in the Deep End". After leaving The Pressures of Time, Brian co-founded Rock Garden, a very popular recording/rehearsal studio among metropolitan New York musicians.

Giving up the day to day operation of the studio, Brian joined forces with The Swingin' Johnsons. The group was a featured act on the syndicated cable TV Show "RASCALS COMEDY HOUR" and performed with such comedians as Rosie O'Donnell and Drew Carey. The band had an extensive tour schedule throughout the Northeast United States. After the group's first CD release in 1999, Brian decided to leave the Johnsons to concentrate on his real passion to build a career in country music.

With the evolution of the new country music scene, Brian drew influences from The Dixie Chicks, Tim McGraw, John Mellencamp, and Creedence Clearwater Revival. Brian has the talent and experience to blend contemporary country with today's commercial pop rock sound.

As Brian leads his band from the drum kit, he gives today's country music a new look, a new sound and captures a generation of new country music fans.....
